In the U.S., a case of breast cancer is diagnosed every **2 minutes**. A woman in the US dies of breast cancer every **13 minutes**.







Bank of America Chicago Marathon

- Sunday, October 11, 2015
- Grant Park, Chicago, IL
- Participant Selection is based on a Lottery System
- **26.2 Miles**
- Participants must be 16 years or older on race day, October 11, to enter the 2015 Bank of America Chicago Marathon. Participants 16-17 years of age must have a parent or legal guardian complete the registration process permitting their participation.
- The 2015 Bank of America Chicago Marathon has a maximum net race day finish time of six hours and 30 minutes (6:30:59). The Marathon course will reopen for public use on a rolling schedule based on this time limit.
- The sale and/or transfer of race entries/bib numbers is strictly prohibited.
- All registration fees and ancillary purchases are nonrefundable.
- All participants are required to show a government-issued photo ID upon picking up their own participant packet (bib number and timing device) at the Abbott Health & Fitness Expo during the scheduled hours of operation.



What is the Lottery System?

Guaranteed Entries with TEAM KOMEN

- ► The Bank of America Chicago Marathon operates under a lottery system, which is the general application process.
- ▶ The lottery is open from March 10, 2015 April 21, 2015.
- If you wish to bypass the lottery, you can choose to run for TEAM KOMEN and receive a guaranteed entry into the marathon.
- Due to the fact that TEAM KOMEN only has a limited number of guaranteed entries, spots are in extremely high demand. They are on a first come, first serve basis.
- You can receive a guaranteed entry from TEAM KOMEN:
 - During the Lottery Available now until April 21st
 - Post Lottery Available after April 28th



Ways to Join Team Komen Guaranteed Entries with TEAM KOMEN

There are 3 ways to join TEAM KOMEN:

Entry Type	Date Available	Required Fundraising Minimum*
During Lottery (Need Guaranteed Entry)	Now until April 21st	\$1,000
Post Lottery (Need Guaranteed Entry)	After April 28 th	\$1,500
Post Lottery (Secured Your Own Entry through the Lottery)	After April 28 th	\$500

^{*}Fundraising minimum does not include the Bank of America Chicago Marathon registration fee.



Alumni Incentive

We Love our TEAM KOMEN Alumni!

Komen Chicago will cover the
Bank of America Chicago Marathon
registration fee for all
TEAM KOMEN Marathon for the Cure members
from the previous 3 years (2012 – 2014).

Registration Fees that will be covered:

- ▶ \$185 U.S. Residents
- > \$210 Residents outside of the U.S.





Fundraising Requirements

- The guaranteed entry charity fundraising minimums are set by the Bank of America Chicago Marathon.
- When you join TEAM KOMEN Marathon for the Cure, you are committing to that <u>required and enforced</u> fundraising minimum.
- Fundraising minimums may not be deferred (i.e. moved to another year or event) or reversed (i.e. changed or cancelled).
- A charity guaranteed entry cannot be deferred.

Entry Type	Required Fundraising Minimum
During Lottery (Need Guaranteed Entry)	\$1,000
Post Lottery (Need Guaranteed Entry)	\$1,500
Post Lottery (Secured Your Own Entry)	\$500

Fundraising Deadlines

- October 31st = Required fundraising minimum due
- Monday, October 5th = If you do not reach your minimum one week prior to the marathon:
 - ➤ Your official participant bib will be pulled from regular packet pick-up at the Bank of America Chicago Marathon Expo (10/9 & 10/10).
 - In order to receive your bib, you will need to complete a credit card information and recommitment form at Komen Chicago's booth at the Expo. Once your form is completed, you will receive a release form to pick-up your official bib.
 - Your credit card will only be charged the difference of what you owe if you do not meet the fundraising minimum as of October 31st.



Fundraising Expectations

- Individuals who take a Komen Chicago guaranteed entry and do not participate or who wish to cancel their participation for any reason, including but not limited to injury, date conflict, move, etc, will still be expected to fundraise.
- Fundraising minimums will be charged on a sliding fee scale based on the date you cancel. We understand that things can happen that may prevent you from completing the marathon. If you need to cancel, we will work with you on a plan to complete your fundraising requirement.
- If you opt-in to the virtual training program or if you are an alumni that had your registration fee covered by Komen Chicago, you will need to re-pay Komen Chicago back for this expense if you cancel or do not participate at any point from when you register with TEAM KOMEN to the marathon.



Fundraising Benchmark Recommendations



We recommend that you follow the below schedule in helping you fundraise.

Date	Fundraising Reached
June 22 nd	Reach 25% of your goal
July 27 th	Reach 50% of your goal
August 31st	Reach 75% of your goal
October 5 th	Reach 100% of your goal!

Note – You qualify for Level 2 (\$250-499.99) if you have raised \$250-499.99 <u>above</u> your required minimum. You qualify for Level 3 (\$500-749.99) if you have raised \$500-749.99 <u>above</u> your required minimum. Same pattern for all levels.

Registration Steps #1 & 2

- Read this information guide and agree to required fundraising minimums.
- 2. Register with TEAM KOMEN Marathon for the Cure via Komen Chicago's website: www.info-komen.org/TeamKomenMarathon
 - Registration will include personal information (i.e. name, address, email), credit card information to be held (you will always be notified before you are charged), marathon history related questions and participant waiver committing to required fundraising minimum.
 - ► There is no fee to join TEAM KOMEN only the commitment to meet your fundraising requirement is required.
 - When you complete TEAM KOMEN's Registration you will be directed to your TEAM KOMEN Participant Center – which is your personal fundraising center. You will receive a guide on how to Navigate Your Participant Center once you register.



Registration Step #3

3. Register with the Bank of America Chicago Marathon –

- Within one business day of registering with TEAM KOMEN, we will send you a unique URL to officially register for the marathon.
- You MUST complete the official registration to receive a guaranteed entry into the marathon. Please <u>do not</u> register multiple times.
- After you submit your application, you will receive an email from the marathon that your application was received.
- After you register, you will be directed to your Bank of America Chicago Marathon Athlete Center. It should look similar to this:



Status: Pending

Komen Chicago will be notified when you submit your official registration. You will see "Pending" until we approve you to join our team.



Registration Step #4

- Complete official registration once Komen Chicago approves you.
 - You will receive an email once you have been approved by Komen.



- Go back to your Athlete Center and <u>complete your registration</u> which includes paying for your registration fee (unless you are a TEAM KOMEN Alumni) and any ancillary items (i.e. photos, etc).
 - ▶ This must be completed by April 21st at 12pm CST.

After you complete your registration, your Athlete Center should look similar to this:


